## Incarnation at a glance

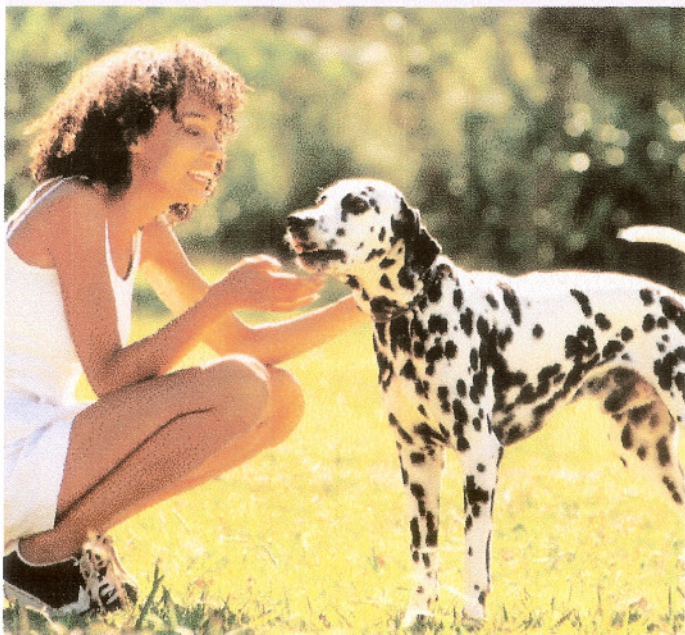
At Incarnation, we believe this church is meant to be:
